




### Statistics and Trends


#### GENERAL EMPLOYMENT PERMIT

This is to certify that the Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment grants this General Employment Permit for the purpose provided for under section 9(2)(c) of the Employment Permits Act 2024.

This employment permit is granted to the foreign national specified, to be in employment in the State in the employment specified and by the person specified as the employer of the named foreign national in relaiton to that employment.


A person who contravenes section 7 of the Employment Permits Act 2024, relating to the employment of Foreign Nationals with an employer in the State, is guilty of an offence.

Permit valid from 24/02/2025 to 23/02/2027



For Minister

- 1. The permit is issued on the basis that the salary to be paid to the named Foreign National is the salary specified on this
- 2. Notwithstanding note 1., the permit is issued on the basis that the salary to be paid to the named Foreign National is, at least, the national minimum hourly rate of pay or an hourly rate of pay fixed or pursuant to any enactment that may apply to the employment concerned as provided for in paragraph (b) of the definition of "standard working week remuneration" in section 2 of the Employment Permits Act 2024 as appropriate.
- 3. In accordance with section 43 of the Employment Permits Act 2024 should the foreign national named below, for any reason, cease to be employed by the employer specified during the period of validity specified, the employer and Permit Holder shall notify the Department of Enterprise, Trade and Employment within 4 weeks of the date of termination or cessation of this employment.
- 4. Section 55 of the Employment Permits Act 2024 prohibits an employer from making any deduction from the Permit Holder's remuneration or seeking to recover from a Permit Holder any charge, fee or expense relating to the application for the permit or its renewal and/or recruitment and travelling expenses in connection with taking up employment in the State. Section 55 of the Employment Permits Act 2024 also prohibits an employer or someone acting on his or her behalf from keeping any personal documents belonging to the Permit Holder.
- 5. An application for a new employment permit or an application for a change of employer, may be made in respect of the named Foreign National subject to eligibility criteria and in accordance with the Employment Permits Act 2024.



### **Employment Permit Requirements**

### **General Employment Permit**

- 1. Minimum Annual Salary: €34,000
- 2. Labour Market Needs Test
  (Jobsireland.ie and another thirty-party job
  posting site for 28 days)
- 3. Not on the <u>Ineligible List of</u>
  <a href="Occupations">Occupations</a>

Spouse/ Children can join after 12 months

Stamp 4 in 60-months

### **Critical Skill Employment Permit**

- **1.** Minimum Annual Salary: €38,000
- 2. Critical Skills Occupation List
- 3. Must have a relevant degree (Lvl 8) or higher qualifications

OR

Minimum Annual Salary: €64,000

Spouse/ Children can join immediately
Stamp 4 in 24-months






